# COLORADO MESA UNIVERSITY (CMU)

**DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:**



### ALL DSF SCHOLARS:

Must meet with the DSF Campus Contact at least once during each semester. These meetings provide you with valuable information to help you succeed in college. Your DSF Campus Contact's information is listed on the side.

Your Campus contact can:

Connect you with campus programs aimed at encouraging academic and social engagement on campus, and make appropriate referrals.

Discuss major declaration, developmental education progress, anticipated graduation date, graduation course plan, meetings with academic advisors, etc.

All DSF scholars must review their 4-year graduation plan with the DSF campus contact each semester, and submit updated plans to the DSF campus contact, as necessary.



### NEW/TRANSFER DSF SCHOLARS:

Must check-in with their DSF Campus Contact within 30 days of the beginning of class each semester.

Incoming DSF scholars must complete a 4-year graduation plan within 30 days of the start of the semester and submit it to their DSF Campus Contact to keep on record.



### RETURNING DSF SCHOLARS MUST:

Required to check-in with their DSF Campus Contact within 60 days of the beginning of class each semester.

Continuing DSF scholars (sophomore - senior year) will be encouraged to have their 4-year graduation plan signed off by their faculty advisor within the first 30 days of the fall semester.



### ALL DSF SCHOLARS - COMPLETE 1 EACH YEAR:

- Attend a Grad Fair, Career Fair, or Mav Power Hour event to explore career options or opportunities in their field of study. [Career Services events](#) or [Scholarship Community Events](#).
- Meet with [Career Services](#) and update or create a resume or cover letter.
- Complete [Pathful Explore](#) and research career opportunities through the O\*Net

### TRIO STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Through workshops, individualized attention and mentoring, TRIO staff assists students in achieving their academic, personal, financial and professional goals.
