COLORADO MOUNTAIN COLLEGE (CMC)

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



NEW, FIRST TIME TO COLLEGE DSF SCHOLARS MUST:



Attend an orientation and registration date at the CMC campus they will be attending. Scholars must connect with the DSF Campus Contact by June 30 to select an orientation and registration date that works best for their schedule.



Check-in with the DSF Campus Contact within 30 days of the beginning of each semester.

RENEWAL DSF SCHOLARS MUST:
