Events are marketed to students through the Student Newsletter, flyers and posters around campus.

Services include completion of the Career Readiness Assessment, participation in Career Launch, connect with employers in Handshake, creating a LinkedIn profile or completion of LinkedIn Learning course, Career Readiness Workshop or meeting with a staff member of Career Coaching and Readiness.
