STUDENT SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2026-27

COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF DENVER (CCD)

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



ALL DSF SCHOLARS (NEW, RENEWAL, TRANSFER):

- DSF Scholars will complete Student Success Requirements (SSRs) no later than **Friday, November 13, 2026 for the Fall semester**, and no later than **Friday, April 16, 2027 for the Spring semester**. Student Success Requirements include:



MEET WITH YOUR DSF CAMPUS ADVISOR:

- Required to meet with Campus Advisor 3 times per semester.
- Examples include one on one meetings, drop-in hours, or a welcome sessions.
- Students applying to Health Science Programs with competitive admissions must attend an info session for that program.
- SEED Participants: Must meet with a SEED College Partner or attend a SEED Social Hour. This will count as a check-in or campus event.



PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST ONE CCD OR DSF EVENT/WORKSHOP EACH SEMESTER.

PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST ONE CAREER EVENT OR OPPORTUNITY EACH SEMESTER.

DSF SCHOLARS ON PROBATION/WARNING STATUS MUST:

- Participate in tutoring if required by assigned DSF Campus Advisor.
