Entry & Exit Points

- Students can begin as an apprentice and earn a Certificate.
- Students can also start in a Certificate program or an Associates of Applied Science program before applying to positions.
- Student can stack a Certificate into earning an AAS or Bachelor's Degree. This stackability can lead to a Bachelor's Degree in Construction Project Management.
