

# ALL ABOUT FAFSA & FINANCIAL AID




## WHAT



The Free Application for Federal **V** Student Aid (FAFSA) is the application used by the U.S. Department of Education to determine your eligibility for federal aid. It is the application for grants, work-study and loans.

### WHO

Students who are U.S. Citizens or eligible noncitizens that are planning to enroll in a college or technical program can apply for FAFSA to be considered for fianacial aid.



#### NON-CITIZENS

Students who are non-citizens may complete an institutional financial aid application for their college of choice.

- 1 Students are eligible for in-state tuition under the ASSET state law
- Besides in-state tuition, students are also eligible for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) to help you pay a portion of your tuition
- There are many scholarships
  you can apply to: Dream.US,
  LAEF, CESDA
- Colleges/universities in Colorado have a separate financial aid application you can fill out. Be sure to check w/ your college of choice
