STUDENT SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2025-26

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



ALL DSF SCHOLARS WHO ARE FIRST-TIME COLLEGE STUDENTS:

- Scholars are required to meet two times with their campus contact
 - The 1st meeting is within a week of starting courses.
 - The 2nd meeting is a month before their course ends.
- Scholars will have to do a check in via phone or video call each month while an EGTC student.
- Scholars must complete a mental health assignment.

STUDENT SUCCESS CENTER

The Student Success Center (SSC) is located in room 653 at the Lincoln campus and is designed to support currently enrolled students throughout their educational experience at Emily Griffith Technical College by offering many services and resources including mentoring, classroom visits and supports, continuing registration, health and wellness awareness campaigns, and community referrals. Appointments with a Student Success Coordinator to discuss and troubleshoot barriers or challenges are available at all campuses. Services provided are individual or in a group setting, and can be confidential if requested.

The SSC works closely with non-profits and community resources throughout the Denver metro area / Colorado and may provide students with information on services that are provided by these organizations. Feminine hygiene products are available in the SSC and Bill's Magical Food Closet located in room 653, provides emergency food items for students while they are in school.
