# RED ROCKS COMMUNITY COLLEGE (RRCC)

**DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:**



**ALL NEW FIRST TIME TO COLLEGE DSF SCHOLARS MUST:**



Attend RRCC new student orientation prior to first semester.



**ALL NEW DSF SCHOLARS MUST:**



Meet with their DSF Campus Contact within 30 days of the beginning of each semester to make an academic plan and connect them with campus programs aimed at encouraging their academic and social engagement in campus, including support with career exploration and preparation.



**ALL RENEWAL DSF SCHOLARS MUST:**



Meet with the Campus Contact within 60 days of the beginning of each semester to review the student's academic performance and plan, prep for next semester registration, review their engagement on campus, and make appropriate referrals, including support with career exploration and preparation.
