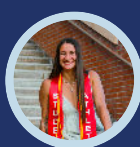

STUDENT SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2026-27

WESTERN COLORADO UNIVERSITY (WCU)

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



ALL DSF SCHOLARS:

Must meet with the DSF Campus Contact at least twice during each semester. The first meeting must occur during the 1st month of the semester. The second meeting is recommended to occur within the 6th- 9th week of the semester. These meetings provide you with valuable information to help you succeed in college. Your DSF Campus Contact's information is listed on the side. Your Campus contact can:

- Connect you with campus programs aimed at encouraging academic and social engagement on campus, and make appropriate referrals. For example; Career Services, Wellness, Counseling, LEAD Office, Clubs, Accommodations, etc.
- Discuss major declaration, developmental education progress, anticipated graduation date, graduation course plan, meetings with academic advisors, etc.
- Review 6- & 9- week interim grades.



Attend a Career Services event each semester.

- This can include workshops, career fairs, industry panels, or stopping in Career Services (UC122) for a 1:1 meeting with a career specialist.



NEW/TRANSFER DSF SCHOLARS:

Must check-in with their DSF Campus Contact within 30 days of the beginning of class each semester.



RETURNING DSF SCHOLARS:

Required to check-in with their DSF Campus Contact within 30 days of the beginning of class each semester.



DSF SCHOLAR SENIORS

Required to meet with the Degree Analyst located in Registration & Advising Services (Taylor Hall 300) ensuring that you are prepared and on track to meet your graduation timeline.
